# ADMISSIONS GUIDE OF DORMITORY

If you wish to move into a student dormitory, follow the steps indicated below. You must be a 2nd year or higher undergraduate student in the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences or Faculty of Engineering, or a graduate student of the Kogushi or Tokiwa campuses

#### 1) Required Documents

(1)	Dormitory Entry Request	Fill out the required information and place your personal seal.		
(2)	Student Statement	Fill out the required information. (See sample form.)		
(3)	Envelope for Results Notification	This will be used to send your application results. Write the address you want the results sent to on a chou #3 (長形 3 号) size envelope and place an ¥110 stamp on it.		
(4)	Tokiwa Dormitory (Bldg. C) Entry Statement (for those wanting to move into Bldg. C only)	Fill out the required information.		
Decuments will not be returned				

Documents will not be returned.

You can download the required forms from the Faculty of Engineering website.

#### 2) Application Period

#### Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> July – Thursday, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025

- Reception is open from 9:00–12:00 and 13:00–17:00, and closed on weekends and holidays.
- If sending by post, they must arrive before the final day of the application period.

#### 3) Announcement of Results

Results will be sent out at the end of August 2025.

- 4) Move-in Day From 1<sup>st</sup> October 2025

- Applications can be sent by post or brought in in person.
- If sending application documents by post, place them in a kaku #2 (角形 2 号) size envelope and write "Dormitory Application" on the front side in red ink.
- 6) Visiting Student Dormitories
  - If rooms are available, you may visit the rooms. Appointment must be made by email at kokuryu@yamaguchi-u.ac.jp

#### 7) Criteria for Occupancy

- (1) Applications will be judged on the basis of the financial situation of the applicant's household (e.g. income and family circumstances) and the time it takes to commute to school. Applications to move into Building C will be judged on the basis of the applicant's reasons for wanting to move in, and his or her understanding and experience regarding international relations. The number of current Japanese and international student occupants are also taken into account.
- (2) You will be given details about moving in after you have been notified of the results.
- (3) Once you have received permission to move in, please do not cancel unless there are special circumstances. If you must cancel due to special circumstances, please contact the Educational Affairs Section of the Student Educational Affairs Division as soon as possible and submit a "Dormitory Entry Cancellation Form" (no specified format).

#### 8) Maximum Applicants

The numbers below may change due to number of current occupants.

#### 9) Points to Remember When Moving in

- (1) Student dormitories are managed and maintained by dormitory student-run residents' associations.
- (2) Dormitories are managed and maintained by residents' associations made up of students, so there are rules that differ from normal apartment buildings, such as cleaning the dormitory and selecting members from residents.
- (3) Dormitory residents must observe the Yamaguchi University Dormitory Rules (see the Yamaguchi University website) and take part in fire prevention activities and cleaning the surrounding area of the dormitory. If you do not follow the rules of the residents' association, you may be evicted from the dormitory.
- (4) Dormitory fees such as rent will be deducted from your Japan Post Bank account.
- (5) Rooms will be allocated by the Tokiwa Dormitory Administrative Office after the occupants have been decided.
- (6) As a rule, duration of occupancy is one year (or until the end of the academic year you move in if moving in the middle of the academic year), but you may continue to renew until you graduate or complete your program. You may also renew if transferring from an undergraduate to a graduate program (unless you were granted permission to move in to the dormitory with conditions). The entrance fee will only be collected once. However, with Building C, renewal may not be granted if your participation in dormitory events has been deemed inadequate.
- (7) <u>If you repeat two consecutive years, you will be evicted</u>. (Special circumstances such as illness do not apply.) As a rule, you must move out of the dormitory when taking a leave of absence or studying abroad—this applies to all dormitories.
- (8) You can register for a parking space from the end of March to April each year. Spaces are limited, so please try to use a bicycle or other means of transportation. The parking fee is ¥12,000 per year.
- (9) Regular mail must be picked up at the dormitory entrance. Registered mail will be delivered directly to your room.
- \*Building B is managed by a residents' association. International students who wish to live in Building B are expected to be able to speak Japanese to a certain degree.



• There are only single rooms available in each dorm building.

- Level 4 (16 rooms) of Dorm C is available for women only.
- Residents of Dorm B share some washing machines. Residents of Women's Dorm and Dorm C should purchase their own washing machines for their personal use.
- The overhead expenses incurred at Dorm B and Women's Dorm will be used to cover the cost of disposing rubbish.
- The overhead expenses incurred at Dorm C will be used to cover the cost of disposing rubbish, organizing some activities and monthly exchange events. As the events are compulsory for every resident, please note that no refund will be made even if you don't participate in the events.
- Deposit will be used to cover cleaning costs when you move out the dormitory. In addition, the amount of fees and expenses to be paid by you and the entrance fee to the dormitory may be subject to change depending on the world situation.

Smoking is prohibited on the premises of Yamaguchi University. Smokers cannot apply for Tokiwa Dormitories.
