- (1) If you have *never* studied Japanese before, take 'Japanese 1' and 'Japanese 1 Extra'

If you would like to change your class level, please attend the Japanese language course orientation on September 27 (Wed.) and let us know your request. #### ① Undergraduate Students, Exchange Students

- Please contact your faculty regarding the period and process for class registration
- All the students need to complete their class registration at their faculty. Each faculty has its own period for class registration. Please contact your faculty's academic section.

#### ② Graduate Students

If you wish to be awarded credit certificates for Japanese subjects, you will first need to apply for the status of "*Credited Auditors*" as soon as each semester starts. Based on the successful application, if you meet all task requirements for the classes, you will be awarded credits and credit certificates. Please contact your faculty's academic section. Course registration procedures must be completed by the end of the registration period.

#### Important notice:

- 1. Credits for Japanese subjects are NOT considered required credits for graduation for graduate students.
- 2. For the application for the status of "Credited Auditors", you need permission from your supervisor.
- 3. Different faculties have different application system. Please contact your faculty for the details.
