 If you would like to change your class level, please attend the Japanese language course orientation on April 7, Mon. and let us know your request. If you are unable to attend that day, please send an e-mail to Tokiwa Campus Japanese Class Coordinator to request a class change.

- Please write an E-mail to the instructor in charge of the class you wish to take and apply for the status of "Credited Auditors". if you meet all task requirements for the classes, you will be awarded credits and credit certificates.
