(2) Japanese language course orientation and Level Check Test

① Japanese language course orientation

Students taking Japanese language classes at Yamaguchi University for the first time are strongly encouraged to attend the orientation session below.

Date and Time: September 28th, Mon. 10:00-10:30 AM

Place: meeting room, 2nd floor, Tokiwa Library, Tokiwa Campus

② Level Check Test (YU-JTEST)

(Only those who need to take the exam, Please check page 2)

Date and Time: September 28th, Mon. 10: 30 AM-12: 00 PM

Place: meeting room, 2nd floor, Tokiwa Library, Tokiwa Campus

-Test duration: Approximately 1 hour

-What to bring: Your YU account ID and password

-Note: If you do not have a YU account yet, please inform us before the test.

(3) How to enroll Japanese classes

- ① **If you have *never* studied Japanese before**, take 'Japanese 1' and 'Japanese 1 Extra'
- ② **If you have taken Japanese classes *at Yamaguchi University before***, please go to the same level class as the previous semester. However, those who have completed "Japanese 1" may take "Japanese 2."

If you would like to change your class level, please attend the Japanese language course orientation on **September 28th**, Tue. and let us know your request. If you are unable to attend that day, please send an e-mail to Tokiwa Campus Japanese Class Coordinator to request a class change.

- ③ **If you are going to take Japanese classes at Yamaguchi University *for the first time***, your Japanese language classes will be determined by the result of the level check test (YU-JTEST) you took when you applied to study at Yamaguchi University. Please inform the Japanese Language Coordinator at Tokiwa Campus of your level.

(4) Japanese classes and Timetable

- Japanese classes offered as General Education subjects are available to all international and exchange students.
- Please attend the classes according to your class level. However, there are cases where you are advised by your class instructors to move to a different class according to your Japanese skills.
- Japanese classes are semester-based. 'A' and 'B' placed in the subject names respectively denote the subject offered in the first semester and in the second semester.

■ Quick Class Guide

Level	Subject	Class Information
1	Japanese1 and Japanese1 Extra	- For absolute beginners. - Introduction to Japanese language alphabet, pronunciation, greetings, and basic expressions and grammar, necessary to start learning Japanese language. - This course has two classes per week. The contents of [Japanese I] and [Japanese1A Extra] are consecutive, so please take both classes. - Textbook 『Irodori Starter (A1)』 *
2	Japanese 2 Extra	- Basic Japanese. In addition to the basic expressions, students will learn common expressions about yourself, your family, shopping, neighborhood, work, etc. - For those who have completed Japanese 1. The prerequisite for this class is that you can read Hiragana/Katakana. - Textbook 『Irodori Elementary1 (A2)』 **
3	Japanese III にほんご 日本語Ⅲ	- 中級レベル。日本文化や現代社会について取り上げ、「読む・書く・聞く・話す」を総合的に学び、これらについて理解し、日本語で伝えられるようにします。 - Intermediate level. Students learn comprehensively to read, write, listen, and speak about Japanese culture and contemporary society, and to understand and communicate these in Japanese.
4	Japanese for Engineering こうぎょうにほんご 工業日本語	- 中級後半から上級レベル。大学での専門的な講義を理解し、レポートを書いたり、発表したりすることができるようにします。 Upper-Intermediate to Advanced. Designed to enable students to follow specialized academic lectures, compose formal reports, and give presentations within a university setting.

- Please write an E-mail to the instructor in charge of the class you wish to take and apply for the status of “**Credited Auditors**”. If you meet all task requirements for the classes, you will be awarded credits and credit certificates.

1. Credits for Japanese subjects are NOT considered required credits for graduation for graduate students.
2. For the application for the status of “Credited Auditors”, you need permission from your supervisor.
3. The application form of “Japanese1”and “Japanese3” must include the seals of your supervisor and the instructor in charge of the class. Please bring the application form to class the first week.
